Fast Facts

PATIENT ELIGIBILITY AND INELIGIBILITY

Conditions for patient eligibility

1. The patient must have a diagnosis of metastatic colorectal cancer.
2. Representative formalin-fixed paraffin-embedded (FFPE) tissue blocks from the primary colorectal tumor with corresponding pathology report must be available for release by the local pathology department. If available for release, a separate FFPE tissue block from an uninvolved margin of resection (normal tissue) is also requested.
3. The patient must be ≥ 18 years old.
4. The patient must have a life-expectancy of ≥ 6 months.

Conditions for patient ineligibility

1. History of non-CRC malignancy, unless the patient is considered by the physician to be disease-free and at low risk for recurrence.
2. Known comorbid medical conditions that would preclude investigational treatment (e.g., active hepatitis B or C; symptomatic cardiac disease; renal insufficiency; bone marrow impairment).
3. Psychiatric or addictive disorders or other conditions that, in the opinion of the investigator, would preclude investigational treatment.
