PATIENT ELIGIBILITY:

<u>Important note</u>: The eligibility criteria listed below are interpreted literally and cannot be waived (per COG policy posted 5/11/01). All clinical and laboratory data required for determining eligibility of a patient enrolled on this trial must be available in the patient's medical research record which will serve as the source document for verification at the time of audit.

1. Diagnosis

The patient must have been enrolled on a frontline COG therapeutic trial for treatment of a primary malignancy; or

The patient must have been enrolled on a COG (or Legacy Group) therapeutic or non-therapeutic trial targeted for long-term follow-up by ALTE05N1 (see Section 4.1.2 for more details and Appendix II for guidance regarding the targeted protocols);

____2. Timing

Enrollment on ALTE05N1 must occur within 24 calendar months of the date the patient was enrolled on a frontline COG therapeutic trial.


