### WF-2502CD: Surgical Thromboprophylaxis Practices in Oncology Patients within the NCORP Network (STOP-VTE)

#### Surgeon/Surgical APP Participant Identification:

- Sites are asked to identify all possible eligible surgeons and surgical APPs at their site for OPEN Step 0 enrollment. There is no limit to the number of eligible surgeons or surgical APPs per site that may be identified for participation in Part 1.

#### Surgeon and APP Eligibility Criteria for OPEN Step 0 Enrollment:

- Surgeons and APPs may include general surgeons, surgical specialists, urologists, and gynecologists performing or providing postoperative care to patients for gastrointestinal, genitourinary, or gynecologic cancer surgery within an NCORP site.
- Surgeons and surgical APPs do not need to be involved in research or have CTEP ID at their site to participate.
- Local NCORP study staff may use the STOP-VTE Study Flyer to approach the surgeon/surgical APP to inform them of the study.
- Step 0 enrollment ensures that potential surgeons and surgical APPs receive an email invitation to complete the study survey.
